

INTERVIEW

The interview process for the approval to teach has the following steps:

Cognitive Assessment

The cognitive assessments will require you to answer questions to assess your literacy, numeracy and problem-solving capabilities.

Emotional Intelligence Assessment

The emotional intelligence assessment will require you to answer questions related to resilience, conscientiousness and proactivity to help identify how you engage, relate and communicate with others

• Online Interview

The questions have been designed to give teachers an opportunity to respond to key themes for teaching in NSW public schools including their:

- knowledge (including pedagogy and syllabus content)
- critical experiences (demonstration of actions that have contributed to student progress and wellbeing, professional practices and support for the school community)
- skills and capabilities (capacity to deliver curriculum and manage critical teaching activities such as classroom management and assessment).
