
Over five centuries of history


The Universitat de València of today is the outcome of more than five centuries of history that have led to the accumulation of knowledge and unique documentary treasures, making it one of the top Spanish universities.



Vniver§itat 🌣 🗈 València

In the 13th century, higher education was establish in the city of Valencia, obtaining in 1245 a *Studium Generale* institution from Pope Innocent IV. However, not until 1499 did the Juries of Valencia draw up the *Constitucions* of what was to become the first Universitat de València, authorized by the Pope Alexander VI Bull on 1501 and the royal privilege of Ferdinand II the Catholic on 1502.





For more than 500 years, the development of the Universitat de València has run in parallel with the development of the city and has been an inextricable part of its urban fabric, creating spaces for teaching, research, creation and dissemination of culture and science as well as knowledge transfer.




