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GENERAL INFORMATION

The language and culture assistant program is an initiative of the Spanish Ministry of Education aimed at providing internships for university students in their senior year (majoring in any subject, but preferably in Languages and Education) and graduates. The language required is English, but the candidates don't have to be native English speakers.

The assistants will have the opportunity to help teach English in Spain in primary and secondary schools or in Official Schools of Languages for an academic year or in some cases only for a semester. Preferred placement in different Spanish regions can be requested but may not be granted.

REQUIREMENTS

All candidates must:

- Have completed a university degree or be in their final year when applying
- . Be highly proficient in English
- . Have basic communicative skills in Spanish
- Have a clean background check.

DESCRIPTION OF ROLES AND CONDITIONS

THE ROLE OF A LANGUAGE ASSISTANT

A language assistant supports teachers of English in primary or secondary education and brings the language and culture of their country into the classroom. Language assistants collaborate with teaching staff in creating teaching materials and planning lessons. Language assistants support language teachers but do not replace them.

At the same time, language assistants improve their own language skills, learn how to become more effective communicators and experience living and working in Spain.

Language assistants receive:

- A scholarship which should cover accommodation and catering expenses, (about 700 euros monthly: it varies according to region)
- . Medical insurance
- An orientation course at the beginning of the stay
- Official certification issued by Spanish education authorities
- Paid school holidays: Christmas and Easter.

Travel and administrative costs to and from the country of origin will be the responsibility of the scholarship recipient.

HOW TO APPLY

The whole application process is done online on a platform called PROFEX.

The application period usually starts in January. For further information about the program you can check on the Ministry's webpage on
