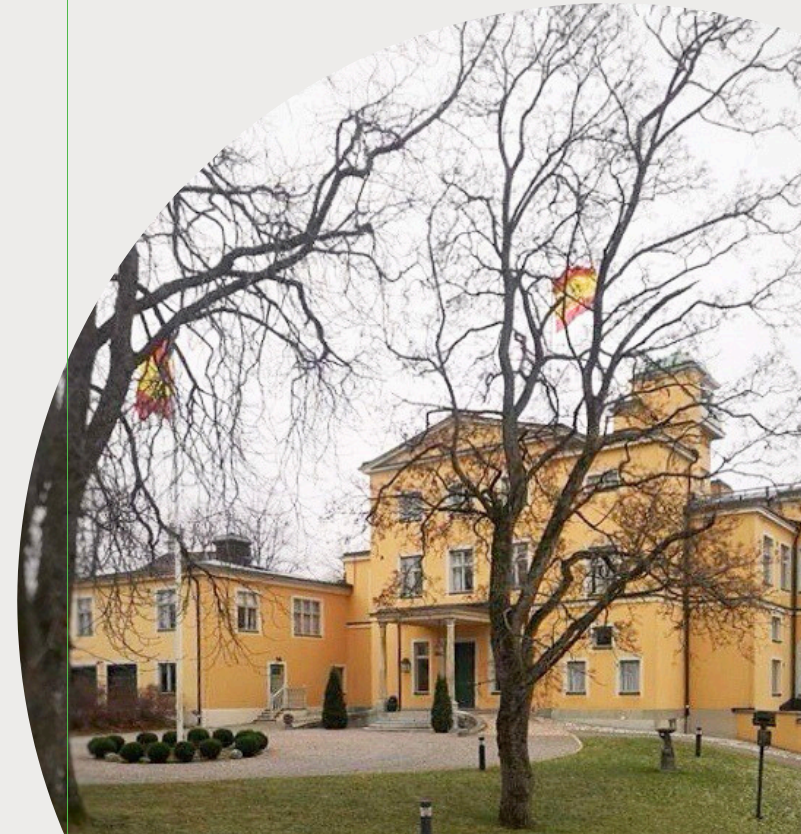

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ABOUT US

The Education Advisory Office in Stockholm is part of the Education Office based at the Spanish Embassy in Berlin, Germany. From there, we coordinate all educational activities conducted across the Nordic countries.

GOAL

The main objective of the Education Office is to promote Spanish education, language, and culture, particularly within formal education. In pursuit of this goal, we foster the learning of Spanish, provide guidance on the Danish, Finnish, Icelandic, Norwegian, Spanish, and Swedish education systems, and assist with the recognition of qualifications in Spain. Additionally, we manage a variety of programs from the Spanish Ministry of Education, Vocational Training, and Sports, ensuring their effective implementation and success across the Nordic countries. From the Education Office, we also foster collaboration with organizations and associations in Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden in the fields of education and Spanish language teaching. **Speak Spanish, discover worlds!**

PROGRAMS



Spanish Language and Culture Assistants

This program allows Spanish graduates and senior undergraduates to spend a school year abroad working as teaching assistants in schools across Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden. The assistants support Spanish teachers by helping students improve their language skills and fostering cultural exchange. Participants receive a monthly stipend from the school or municipality where they work, along with an additional allowance to cover travel expenses from Spain.

English Language Assistants in Spain for Applicants from Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden

This program is for applicants from Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden who wish to spend a school year in Spain as teaching assistants. They assist English teachers in Spanish schools and receive a monthly stipend to cover living expenses, as well as medical insurance, from the Spanish government. This opportunity allows participants to immerse themselves in Spain's educational system while enhancing their language skills and cultural understanding.

SERVICES



Teacher Training

We offer free teacher training courses, workshops, and seminars for Spanish teachers from Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden. Throughout the school year, they can access training opportunities for training in their home countries and have the option to participate in a one-week training program in Spain during the summer.
