Extreme Sports

Extreme sports are not only about fun and skill, but they are also dangerous. They are individual sports with very few rules. People who do extreme sports use their skills and their experience to control what they do. That control makes surfing, skateboarding, mountain biking or coasteering sports not just dangerous games.

Each sport is different. Surfers catch and ride waves in the sea, but there are many kinds of surfing. If you are a beginner, longboards are the best ones for you. They are easier, and they also catch smaller waves. Big Wave is the most extreme end of the sport, with waves up to twelve metres high.

Another example of a popular extreme sport is mountain biking. The main difference to ride on a regular bike and a mountain bike is that the former is much faster and stronger than normal bikes.

Pamela Johnstone is only 14 years old, and she started skateboarding when she was only nine. She was the youngest in her skateboarding city competition. She skates with her older sister Lindsay, who has won 15 competitions. Lindsay has been to an international competition with their club and has broken the national record.

Coasteering consists of exploring the coastline without worrying about a coastal path or finding a rocky cliffy cove blocking your route. You climb, dive and swim. There are about 15 operators in the UK offering coasteering. When you go coasteering, you are in the impact zone where seawater, waves, and land create the world's highest energy natural playground.

If you are interested in any of these sports, you should join the right club. You can learn the sport chosen and borrow the equipment if you need it.
