60-HOUR - THREE WEEK COURSE PROGRAMME

Spanish language and cultural optimisation through the performing arts and media

TARGET AUDIENCE:

The course is aimed at teachers and professionals linked to Spanish language and culture learning. Non-university Spanish teachers. Education administrators and coaches. B2-level language skills.

AIMS:

- Reflect on the pedagogical strength of using drama techniques to enhance communication skills in learning Spanish as a foreign language
- Refresh knowledge about current Spanish society and culture, especially through studying contemporary plays and films
- Incorporate drama and film techniques in teaching practice
- Improve Spanish language skills and enhance oral expression, especially through participation in class activities, theatre practice and short films.

CONTENT:

- ELE language and teaching approaches (20 hours)
- Theatre, cinema and sociocultural reality (15 hours)
- Theatre and didactics (10 hours)
- Spanish in the media (10 hours)
- Cultural activities (5 hours).

Cultural Activities:

Orientation session with a guided tour around Santander

Field trip: Castro Urdiales and Bilbao (Guggenheim Museum).

PRESENTATION

The Universidad Internacional Menéndez Pelayo (UIMP) is the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport's attended university institution specialised in teaching Spanish. Founded in 1932 and designed as a high culture centre, renowned academics, scientists, politicians, designers and other professionals in all areas of knowledge from Spain and overseas are invited to teach in Santander at La Magdelena Palace and on Las Llamas Campus, and at different sites in Spain.

SANTANDER- Las Llamas Campus

Located on the Catabrian coast, Santander is home to one of Europe's most beautiful bays. The city is the capital of Cantabria, a region that is one of the top destinations for Spanish tourism thanks to its wealth of nature and landscapes combining the ocean and high mountains in just a few short kilometres, highly diverse ecosystems, excellent cuisine and a wide range of sporting and leisure activities for all ages.

The university's main site in Santander is located on **Las Llamas Campus** (Avenida de los Castros, 42), the permanent base for Spanish courses throughout the year.

During summer, Spanish courses run alongside continuous vocational seminars for professionals at the Magdalena Palace. Students have free access to a wide international selection, alongside an excellent packed programme of cultural activities.

ASSESSMENT

ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

Accommodation will be reserved at Las Llamas Campus, Avenida de los Castros, 42. 39005 Santander, tel.: (34) 942-298.700, in a single room, from Sunday, from 4 in the afternoon. Check out will be, before 10 am.

Accommodation for course participants is in the university halls of residence. Family members cannot be housed here since there are only single rooms. Rooms come equipped with bedding and towels. The cleaning service is included.

Medical insurance

Students from member nations of the European Union are recommended to bring their E-111/128 with them so that they can use the Spanish Public Health Service if necessary. For this they should request the corresponding form from the health authority in their home country.

Students without health cover in Spain are recommended to take out medical insurance before they travel.

Library

Location: Main classroom block (above the cafeteria) Monday, Wednesday and Friday: 9.00 am to 15.30 pm.

Tuesday and Thursday: 15.00 pm. to 18.00 pm.

90% of the collection is open access. It houses books suitable for the courses: language, linguistics, art, geography, history, Spanish and Latin American traditions, literature...

There is also a sound archive service with different Spanish recordings and a film library with Spanish feature films and documentaries. Students have open access with their UIMP student card and take out books and sound and film recordings on loan

Communal areas and services

The hall has communal study and leisure areas for residents, who may use them whilst respecting the rights and requirements of other users. The kitchen (upon prior request at reception), the gym, the study and computer rooms in block number 4, as well as the television rooms in the Services Block are also open to residents.

Laundry

Sheets and towels are changed weekly and the cost is included in the price.

Residents may use the laundry service, paying the corresponding fee. To do so, they need to hand in their duly tagged clothes at the laundry.

Location: Services Block

Opening times: Monday to Friday, 8am to 3pm

There is also a self-service laundry with washers and dryers.

Sports

Students and lecturers on the courses may use the sports courts (five-a-side, basketball and tennis) as well as a gym (second floor in block 4). The necessary equipment (balls, rackets, etc.) need to be requested at Campus reception and returned after use.

Parking

As far as is possible, Las Llamas Campus will provide parking space in the residents' car park. No motor homes or similar vehicles allowed.
