Abstract

Background

Psychotherapists must choose from an overwhelming number of theoretical models and empirically supported treatments to guide their work. Meta-analytic studies show there is comparable efficacy among the choices, making the decision about which approach to use difficult. Research indicates there are pantheoretical elements found in all effective models, called the common factors, which can offer psychotherapists a focusing point to maximize their effectiveness regardless of their chosen approach. Most psychotherapists begin practicing from a traditional theoretical orientation, but then their approach evolves over time toward an

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

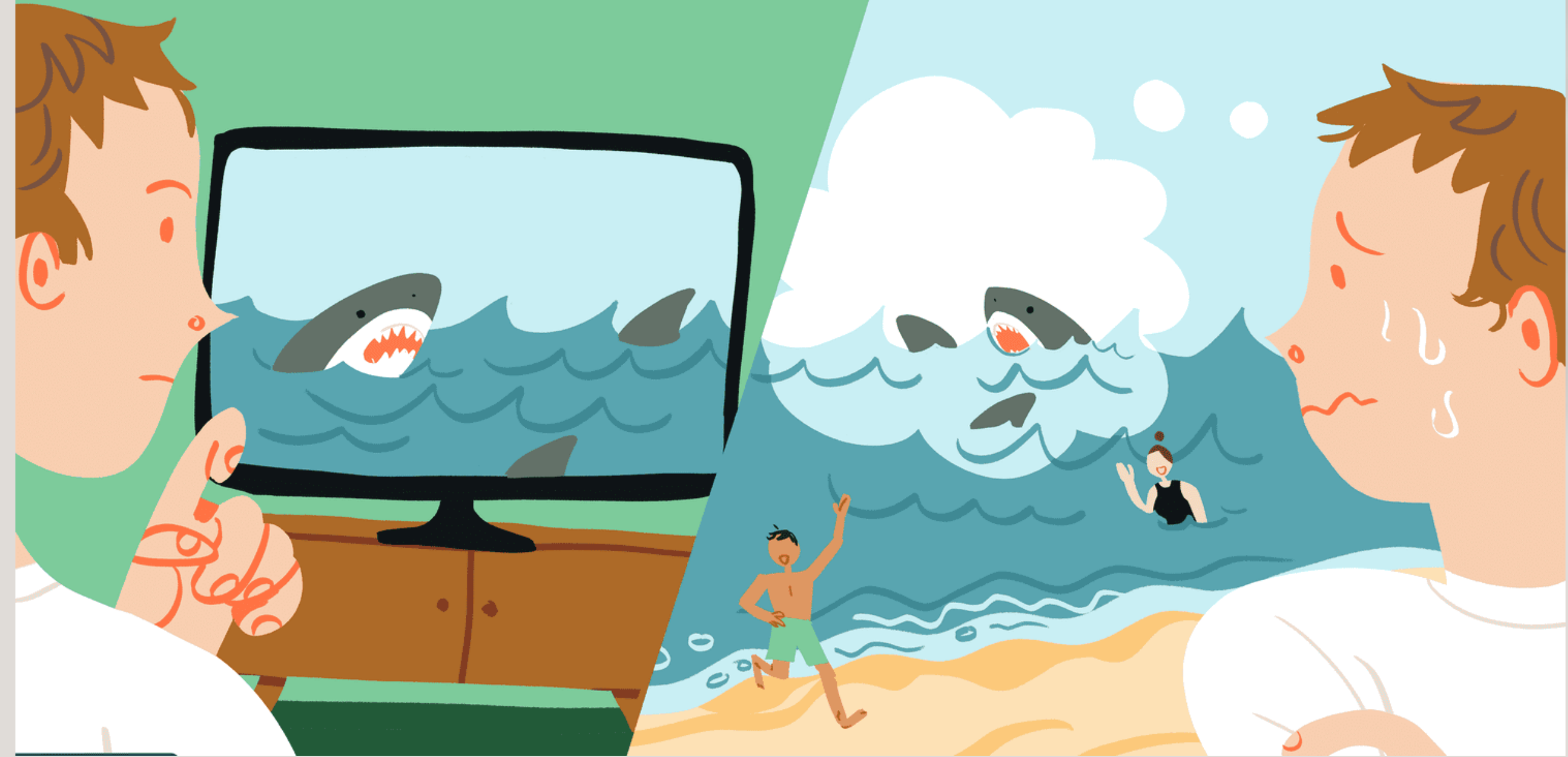
- Evidence-based practice does not equal empirically supported therapy.
- Evidence concerning clinicians' attitudes toward evidence-based practice is reviewed.
- Sources of professionals' resistance to evidence-based practice are examined.
- Misconceptions regarding evidence-based practice are delineated.

What comes to mind quickly is deemed significant—sometimes incorrectly.



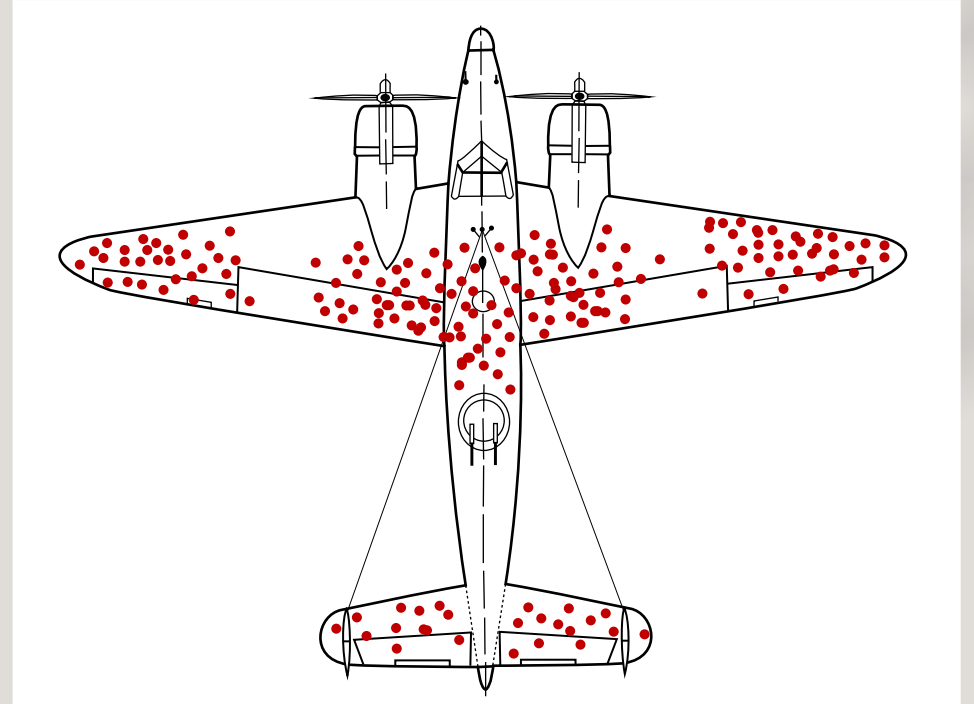

Abstract

There is growing concern about the role of social media use in the documented increase of adolescent mental health difficulties. However, the current evidence remains complex and inconclusive. While increasing research on this area of work has allowed for notable progress, the impact of social media use within the complex systems of adolescent mental health and development is yet to be examined. The current study addresses this conceptual and methodological oversight by applying a panel network analysis to explore the role of social media on key interacting systems of mental health, wellbeing and social life of 12,041 UK adolescents. 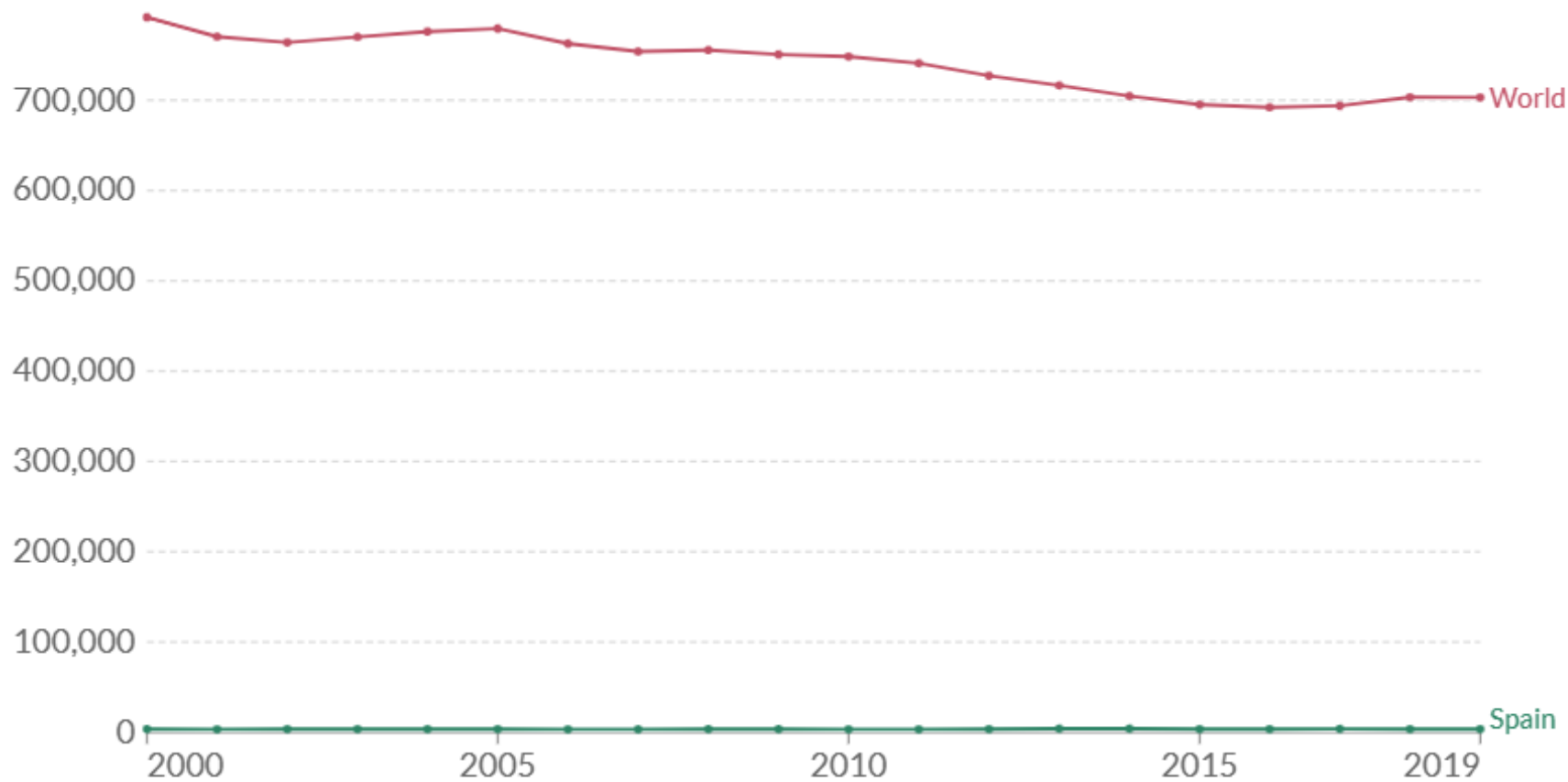
- Does social media use predict mental health problems in adolescents?
- We measured social media use and symptoms of depression/anxiety through interviews.
- Four waves of data from a Norwegian birth cohort were used (10, 12, 14, and 16 years).
- The frequency of posting, liking, and commenting was unrelated to future symptoms.
- Symptoms of anxiety and depression also did not impact future social media use.

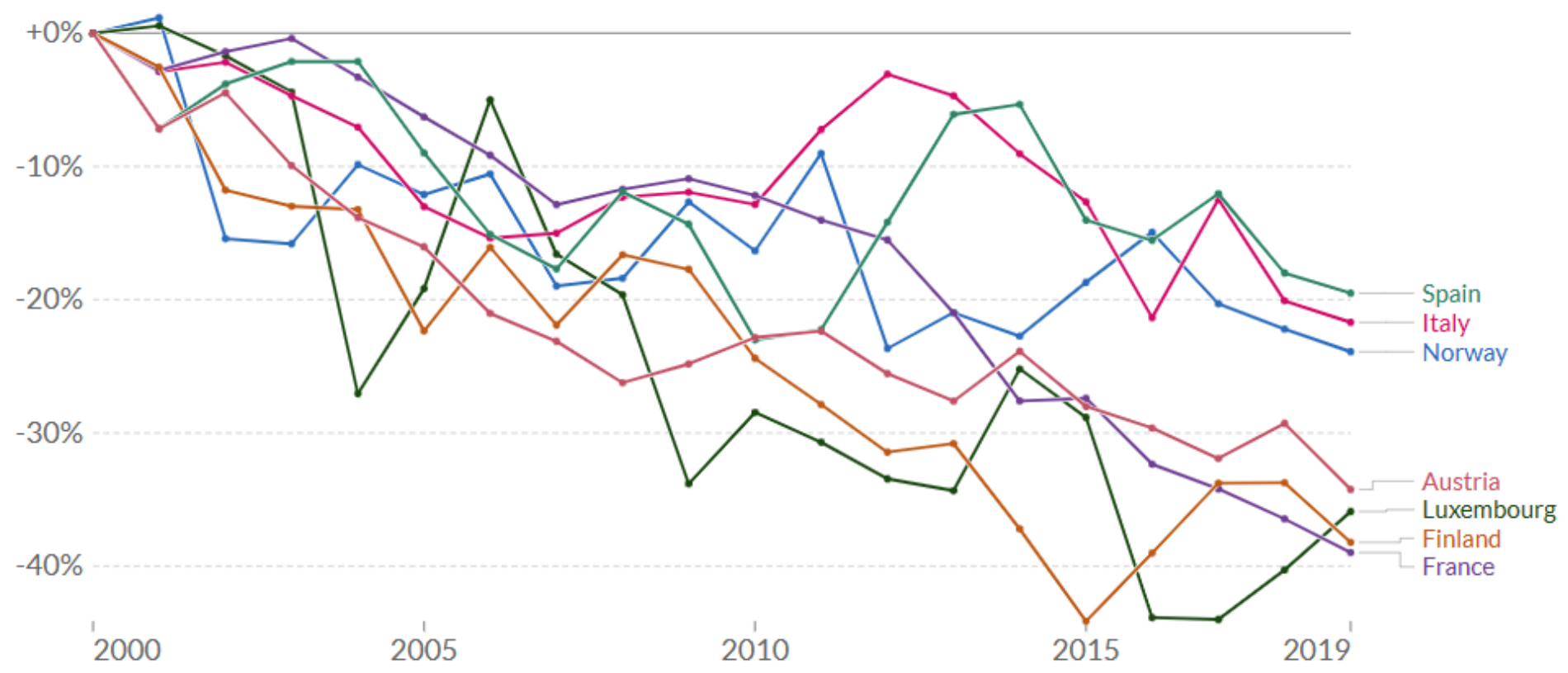

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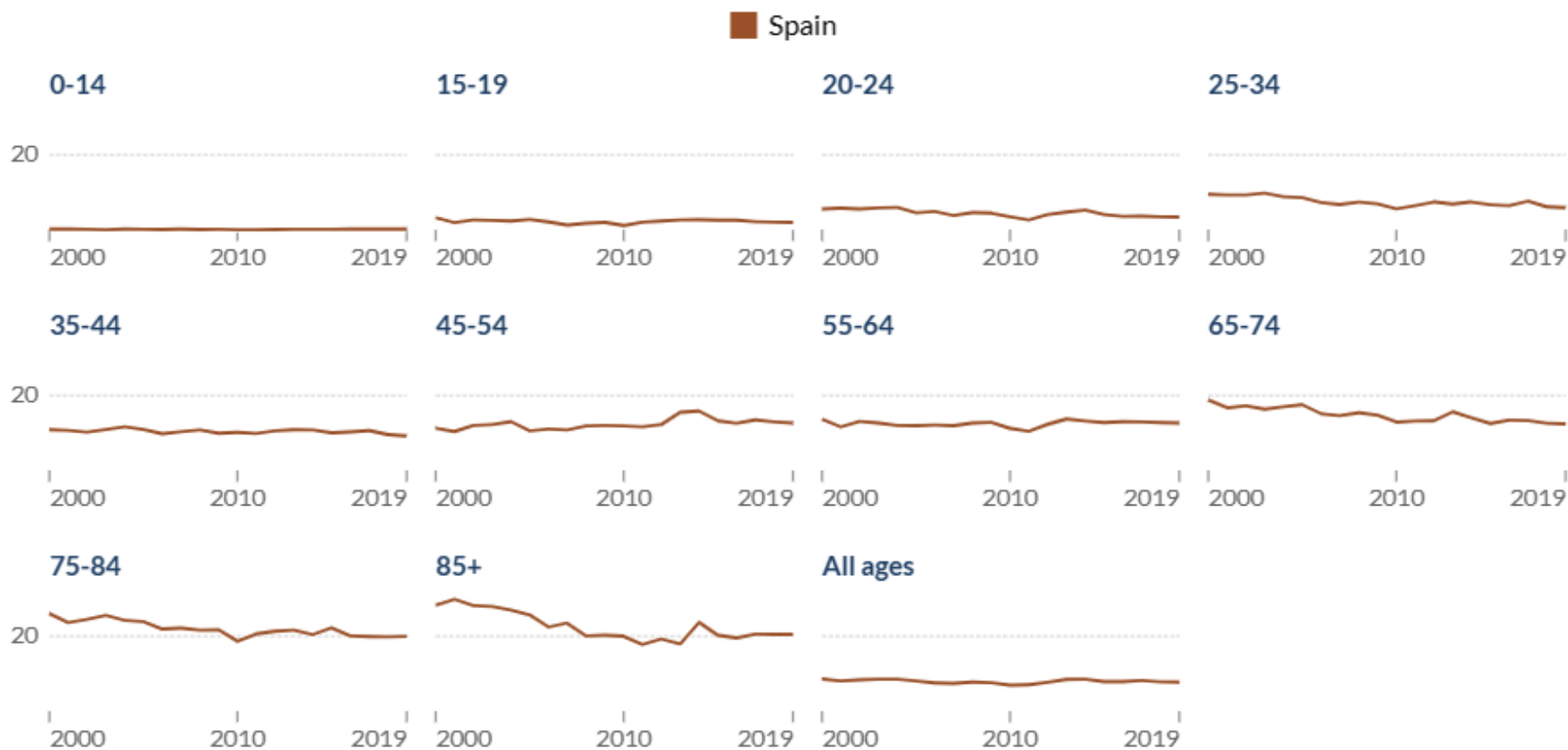
Suicide rate, by age, Spain, 2000 to 2019



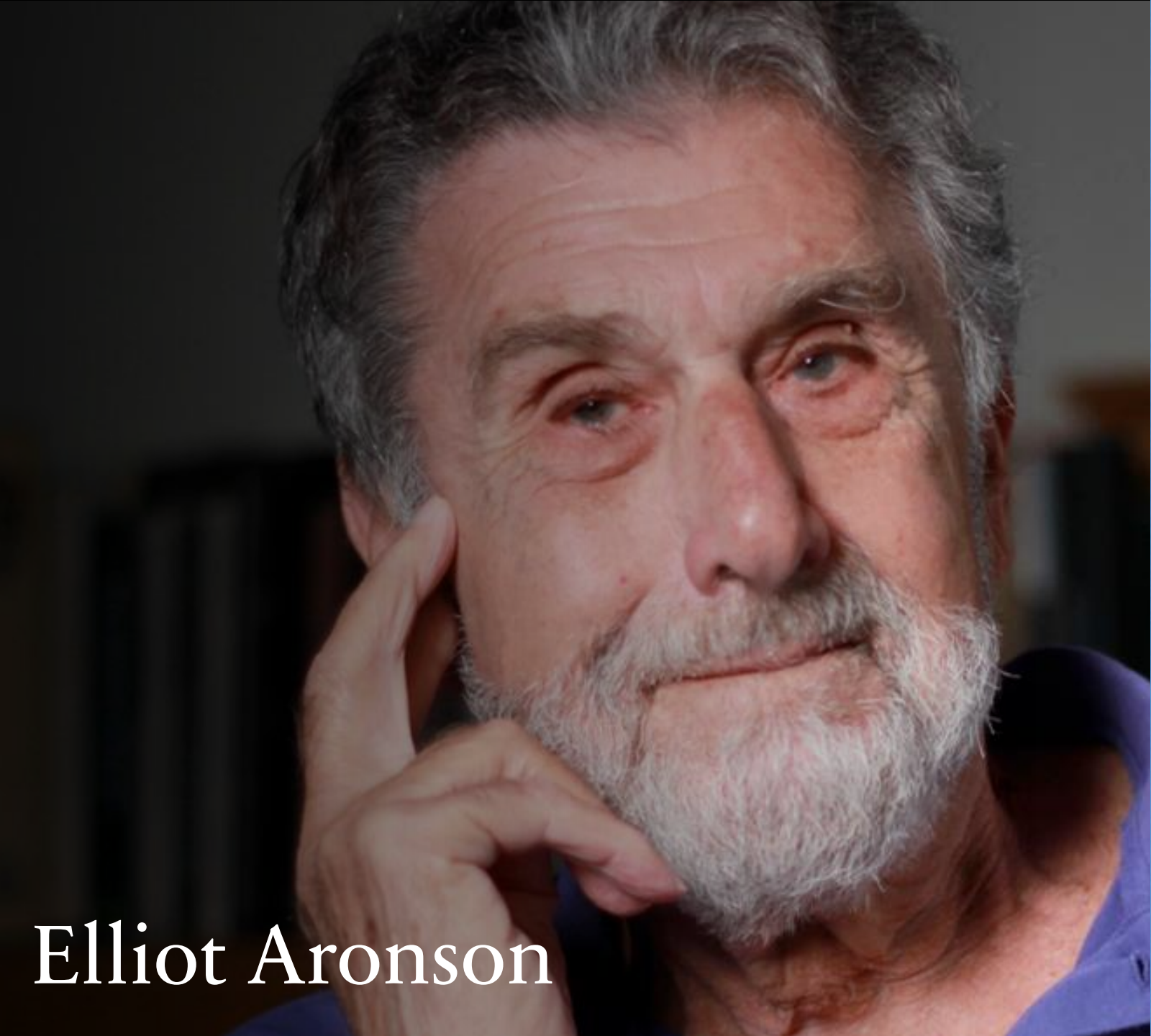

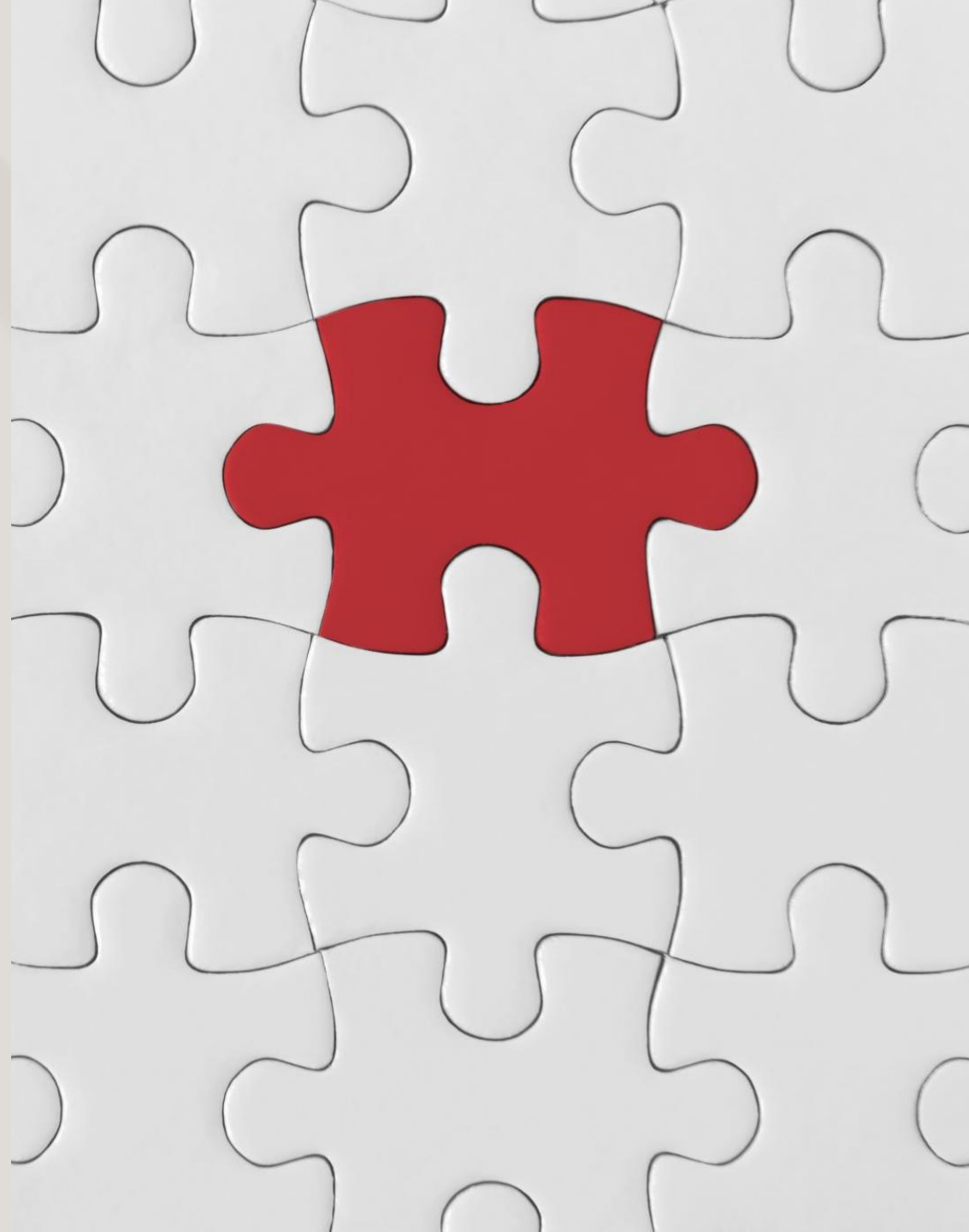


Polarización grupal

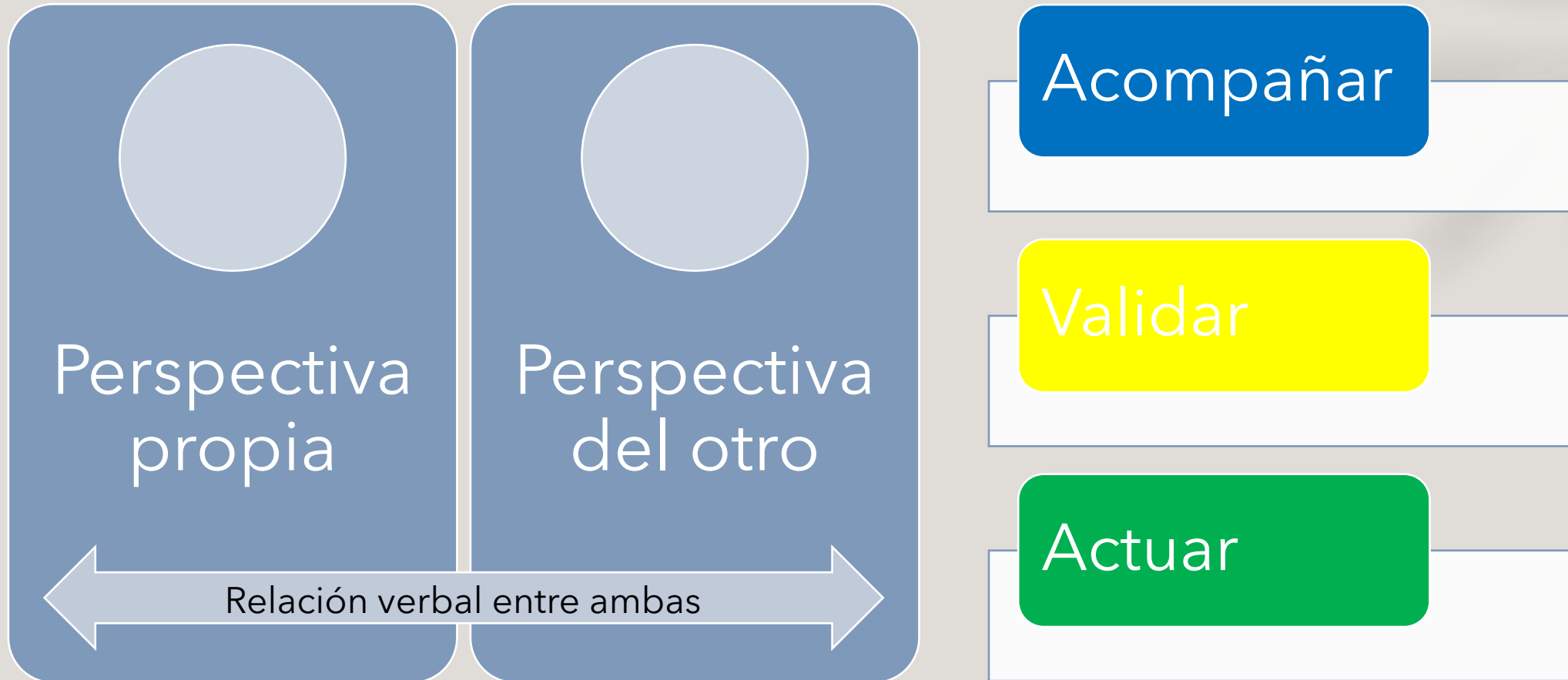


Cómo implementar

10. Examen



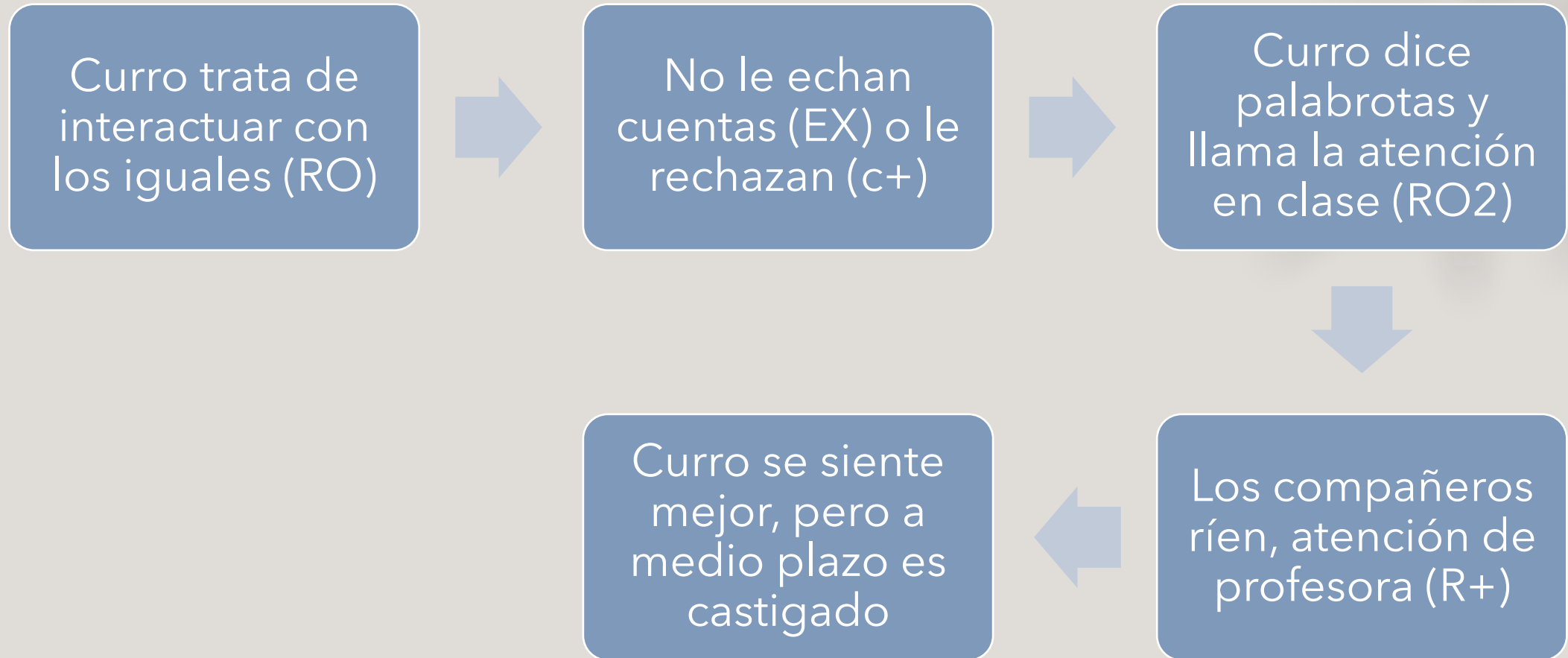
