2. SPANISH AT UCLM













The UCLM and its Spanish Program in Toledo are accredited by Instituto Cervantes, an international recognition that implies a commitment to quality, innovation, and continuous improvement. It is therefore an assessment of the quality of the institution in the academic, teaching and service fields.

In addition, UCLM is a member of SICELE, a multilateral initiative of higher education institutions in Spanish-speaking countries that, together with the Cervantes Institute, aim at







harmony, transparency and consistency in the recognition or accreditation of the proficiency of the Spanish language as a foreign language.

These recognitions give UCLM the ability to prepare DELE certification tests and become a SIELE Accreditation Centre.

Finally, our University is also a member of the Association of Language Centres in Higher Education (ACLES), which aims to promote the learning and teaching of modern languages in the field of higher education.

3.-HEADQUARTERS OF THE COURSE. TOLEDO CAMPUS

Toledo is a city with one of the richest stories in Spain. Muslims, Jews, and Christians lived in harmony here for centuries, leaving their indelible mark on the streets, monuments and buildings of Toledo. Its old town was declared a World Heritage Site in 1986 and is surrounded by the Tagus River. Currently its image is a tourist symbol of Spain and is one of the most visited places by international tourism.

Toledo is the capital of the Castile-La Mancha region and, therefore, its administrative centre. It is a modern city and only 20 minutes from Madrid and therefore connected with the rest of Spain.

UCLM has established its presence in Toledo on two different campuses: faculties of Social Sciences and Humanities in the historic district of the city; and the Science and Technology campus at the former Arms Factory.

A campus with university spaces in renovated heritage buildings with more than 6,000 students.

4. DESCRIPTION OF THE PROGRAM

The academic program of this course that we present to you will be developed over three weeks and will have theoretical and practical sessions, applying a methodology that allows you to learn through personal experience.

Its academic content is structured into three major weekly blocks that allow us to know and live the history, culture and art of Spain while at the same time deepening the historical roots of Spanish and the new methodologies of teaching Spanish as a foreign language (ELE).

The course consists of 60 hours of classroom content organised as follows:

6. INFORMATION OF INTEREST

Course development dates: from July 1st to 20th.

Scheduled timetable: Monday to Thursday (morning and afternoon), Friday (morning).
