It is aimed at young Hungarian graduates or senior year University students with a high command of the English language.

The language assistants are assigned to primary and secondary State schools in Spain for a full academic year.

The language assistants help and support the classroom teacher in reinforcing the students' oral skills in the foreign language and contribute to develop cultural awareness.



Language & Culture Assistants to Spain

WHAT IS IT?

- The Assistants are assigned to elementary/ secondary public schools in Spain to help and support classroom teachers reinforce the students' oral skills in English as well as to develop cultural awareness.
- The positions are for a full academic year, starting typically in October through May 31 each year.
- Assistants get a € 800- €1,000 monthly stipend for a typical 14-16 teaching period weekly schedule. Medical insurance is provided on the basis of the EHIC (European Health Insurance Card). No travel or accommodation expenses are included.
- Hungarian candidates can choose 12 Spanish regions (Asturias, Catalonia, Extremadura, La Rioja and Navarra are not possible)
- The Regions of Madrid and Valencia offer a grant of 1000 euros with a 16 hour schedule.
- The selection process is run locally by the Education Office.

WHY JOINING THE PROGRAMME?

- A unique opportunity for language and cultural immersion.
- A chance to get an insight on a different school system.
- An opportunity to share your cultural heritage and meet people from very different backgrounds.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

To be considered as a candidate, you should:

- Hold Hungarian nationality or hold a permanent residence permit in Hungary.
- Have at least a C1 level of English.
- Be a University Graduate in any field or a senior university student.
- Be in good physical/mental condition. If selected you will need to produce a letter signed by your doctor stating that.
- Have a clear police record.
- Have a strong motivation to work with young students and be willing to become an Ambassador of Hungarian Culture.

YOU CAN FURTHER SUPPORT YOUR APPLICATION IF:

- You have some knowledge of Spain/Spanish.
- Have participated in Study Abroad programs.
- Have an open mind and an intercultural profile.
- Have participated in Youth Programmes.

HOW CAN I APPLY?

- Online. You will have to fill in your application on PROFEX2 (the Ministry of Education's tool for international programs). You can find more information on our website: www.educacionyfp.gob.es/hungria
- If any problem arises during the registration process, the Education Office can provide support.
- You can choose up to three regions in Spain.
- The application process is OPEN February, 11 until March 26, 2025.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Candidates in good standing will be shortlisted and called for a personal interview (Skype is also an option).
- Selected candidates will apply for the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) at their local Social Security office prior to the departure.
- Selected candidates will be assigned to a school in one of the regions of their choice. Specific cities cannot be guaranteed.
