Martin is an Assistant Director in the Assessment Department of Cambridge English and is responsible for the development of new assessment products. This has included the development of *Cambridge English: Legal, Cambridge English: Financial* and the *Cambridge English Placement Test*. Martin is also responsible for the Cambridge English Curriculum, the Cambridge English benchmarking service and Learning Oriented Assessment products. His work in these areas has meant leading on national projects for Ministries of Education in countries such as Malta, Chile and Malaysia. It has also included management of the language test production for the multilingual European Survey on Language Competences (ESLC/SurveyLang) for the European Commission between 2008 and 2012.

Before joining Cambridge English, Martin gained extensive experience in English language teaching and school management in Spain and Japan. He is qualified in PRINCE2 project management and Managing Successful Programmes (MSP) and holds a master's degree in Applied Linguistics, specialising in language testing, from the University of Reading.
