PLACEMENT Length:

- Full academic year: October to May/June or
- Semester: January to May/June

Hours:

• 14 to 16 classroom hours a week + class preparation time

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



New Zealanders, candidates from Fiji or Tonga, citizens of Vanuatu or the Solomon Islands residing in Fiji



Be highly proficient in English (native-like command)



Hold a university degree or be an undergraduate student enrolled at least in your second year



Be of sound mental and physical health, without impairments that may affect your ability to teach



Have a clear police record



Some knowledge of Spanish is advisable, but not compulsory

BENEFITS



Tax-free monthly stipend of at least 800 euros for 14 classroom hours a week



Health coverage



Ample opportunities to travel and explore Spain

RESPONSIBILITIES



Support Spanish teachers of English, or of other subjects such as science, social studies or physical education, delivered in English, in primary and secondary schools or in state language schools (for adult learners)



Plan activities and produce resources to enhance oral comprehension and speaking skills in English and to develop awareness of New Zealand culture
