What is CLIL?



 CLIL stands for Content and Language Integrated Learning

 CLIL is an approach for learning content through an additional language, thus teaching both the subject and the language, in this case, Maths and Spanish.

Why CLIL?



- This kind of approach has been identified as very important by the European Commission because `It can provide effective opportunities for pupils to use their new language skills now, rather than learn them now for use later.'
- CLIL has proven to be successful in many Western countries, including Spain.
- Learning a second language has become more and more important in a globalised world.

Why Spanish?


- Over 100 million people speak Spanish as a second language
