Our integrated approach in Early Years online course

We are delighted to launch our **new self-access online course** and **strongly recommend that** all **new and relatively new Early Years teachers** in Bilingual Education Programme (BEP) schools apply. The course will help teachers become familiar with our literacy based approach to teaching English across the curriculum in Early Years and help you use our updated Guidelines "Orientaciones para el desarrollo e implementación del currículo integrado en el 2º ciclo de Educación Infantil".

The course is open to all Early Years teachers whether designated as teachers, Asesores Lingüísticos &/or coordinators. It has been developed exclusively for teachers in our Bilingual Education Programme and the participation costs (platform licenses) are covered by the British Council in Spain.

Our first course will run over 4 calendar weeks: 6 November until 6 December 2023.

Teachers will receive <u>a certificate of participation</u> on finalising the course which will state course dates, completion rates and scores. You will also be asked to compete a feedback survey.

Here are some basics.

- The course is a Small Private Online Course (SPOC) delivered on our supplier's platform (ECOM Learning Solutions).
- The course is a **9 hour**, self-access course (3 hours of learning per week) + 1 hour platform familiarisation module. There is a mix of video tutorials, texts to read and interactive learning activities to complete.

- The 3 modules focus on the **main aspects of our approach** as outlined in our current Guidelines / *Orientaciones*.
- The courses is **100% self-access** so teachers can work through at their own pace but SMS reminders will be sent to help participants complete the learning.

- All applications must complete the online application form correctly and submit on time.
- New or relatively new teachers and Asesores Lingüísticos to BEP Early Years are strongly encouraged to apply but experienced teachers are very welcome to join
- There are up to 200 places available.

- 6 November 6 December : course open for self-study and completion
- 1-15 December : feedback survey + certificates of participation issued
