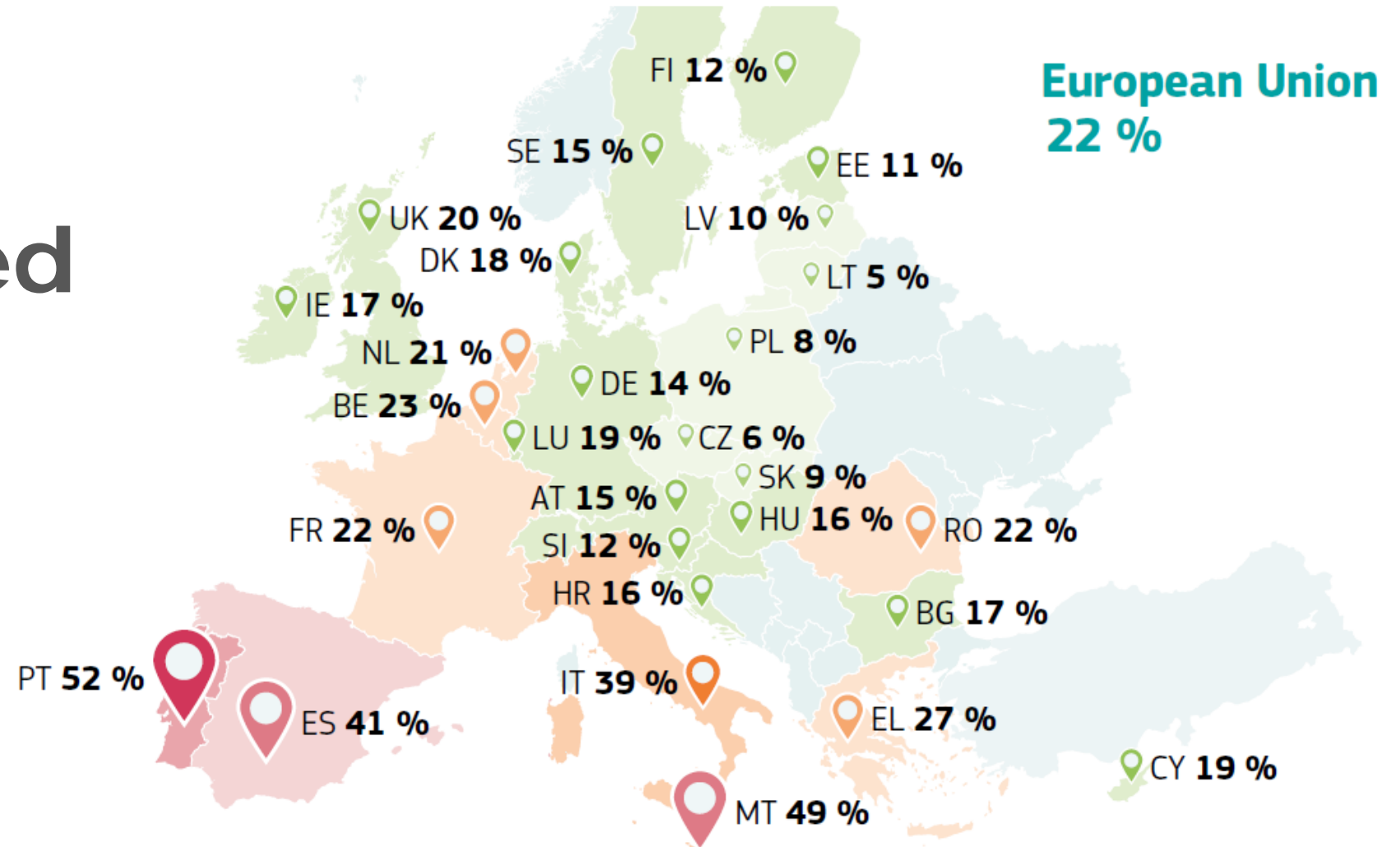


Adult learning challenges in Europe



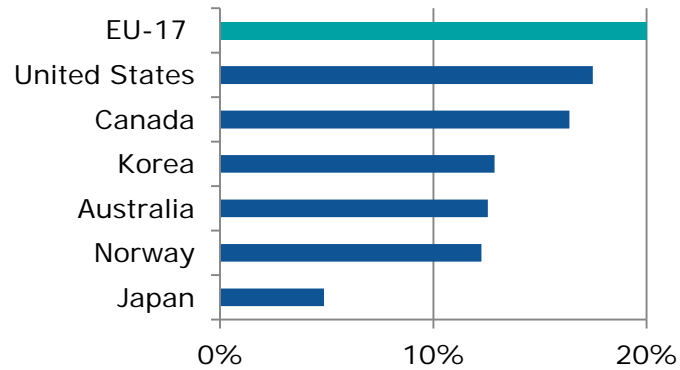
- There are more than **270 million** adult Europeans but only **11.1%** of them have a recent learning experience
- More than **4 in 10** adults in the EU who **did not take part in learning** reported that they **did not want to**

Share of low-qualified adults in the EU

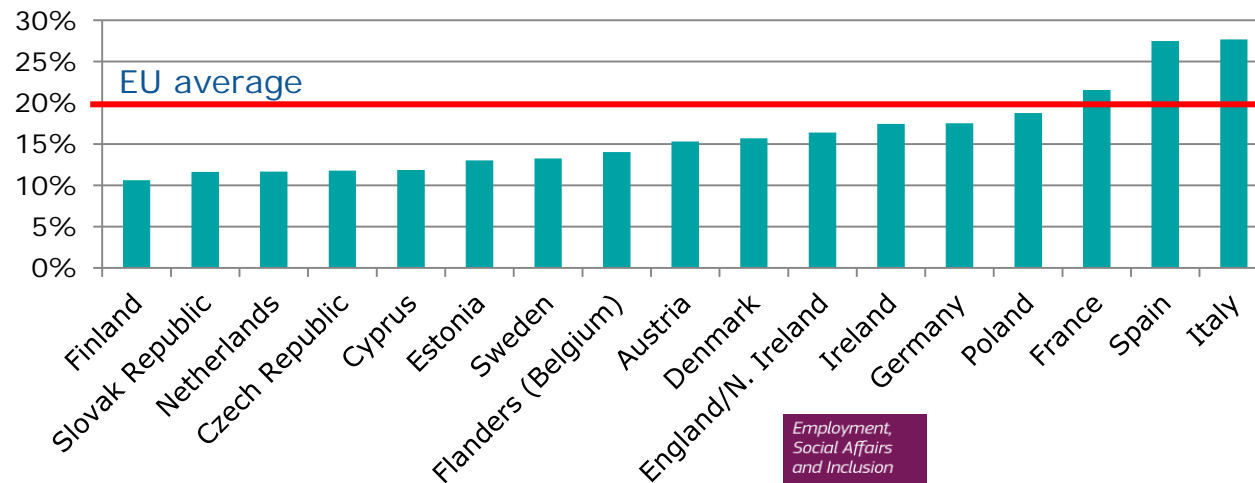
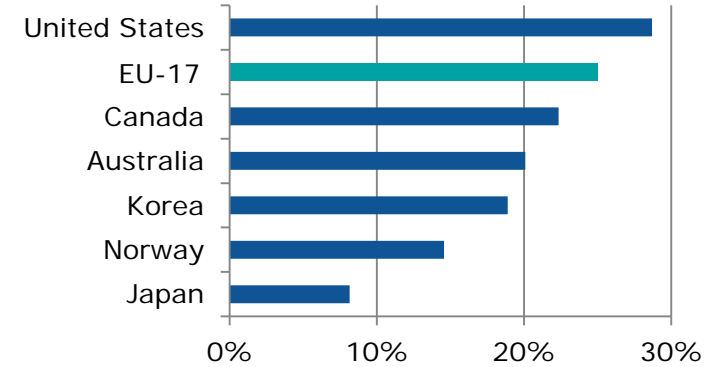

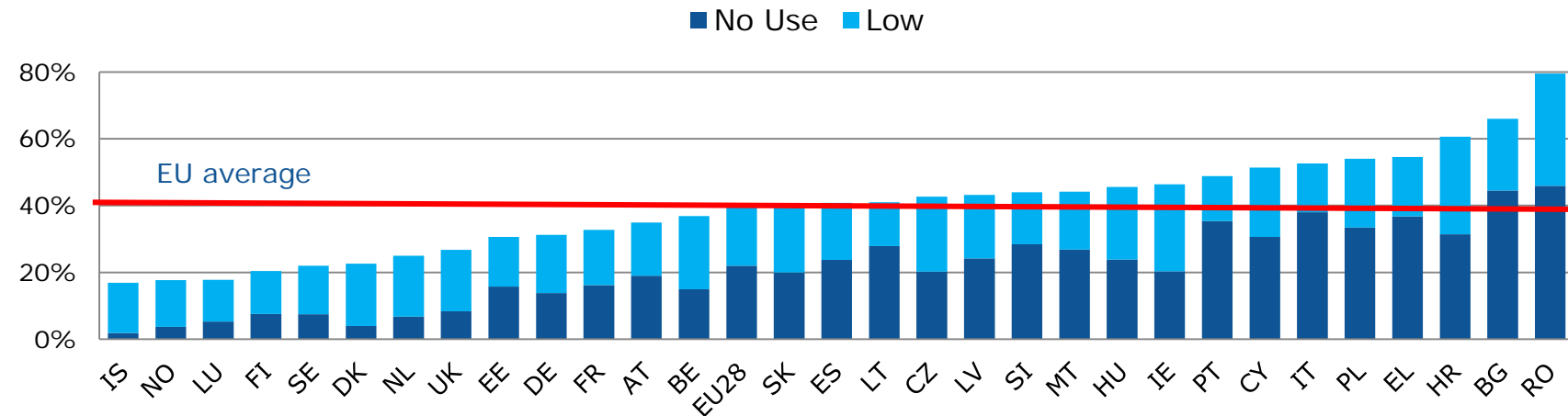

Agenda is being implemented both on EU and national levels

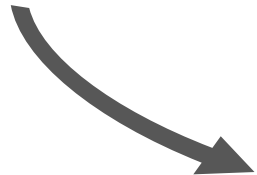
Growing expectation that adult learning systems should respond to national and EU challenges in fast-changing contexts



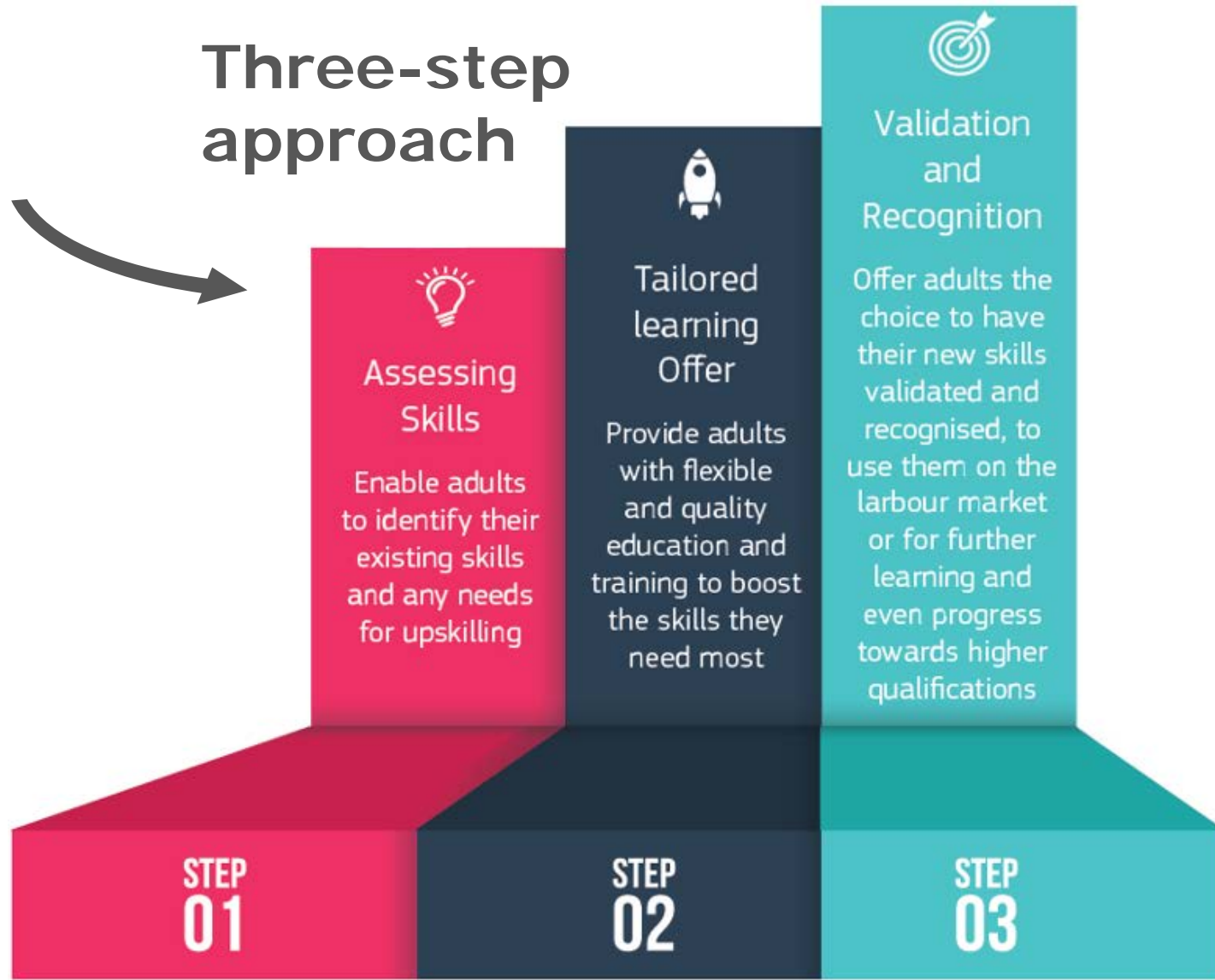

Conclusions

Remaining challenges

- Increase the **scale** of the action
- Embed more strongly **basic skills** into skills assessment and training offers targeting low skilled adults
- Improve **outreach, guidance and support measures**
- Strengthen **coordination and partnerships** between providers and other stakeholders
- Ensure long-term **systemic approach** accompanied by appropriate **funding** resources and mechanisms
